ABOUT THE EVENT

The "Inter-Company Challenge" of the Fort Boyard Challenge is an event that takes place in a 4-seater Polynesian Canoe and, since the previous edition in 2024, also includes a Golf event.

October 4th will therefore be a "sporty" day, with a team ranking for the golf event in the morning and a team ranking for the canoe event in the afternoon. The prize-giving ceremony will be based on these two combined rankings.

No level of practice is required for these two events; beginners are welcome as the events are accessible to all.

Saturday, October 4th: Reception at 9:30 am at Golf Rochefort Océan in Saint Laurent-de-la-Prée

The registration fee includes organization costs, equipment rental (golf and canoe), safety device costs, and the event t-shirt. You are also cordially invited to participate in the Saturday evening organized by the Fort Boyard Challenge for all participants of all FBC events.

The organization reimburses the registration (only the registration amount and excluding ancillary costs) to the Fort Boyard Challenge only upon presentation of a medical certificate justifying an injury/contraindication to sports practice.

In case of inability to participate in the event, it is not possible to transfer your registration to another company.

Photographs and films will be taken during the event. By participating, I authorize the organizer to use these photos and films (free of rights) in which I will appear for the promotion of the event and its partners.

RACE NOTICE

1. RULES

- 1.1. Commitment Rules Each team member voluntarily commits, ensures their ability to practice physical activity and their ease in the aquatic environment. Thus, they release the organizer from any responsibility regarding their health condition and inherent problems related to the practice of Polynesian canoeing and golf.
- 1.2. The specific rules indicated below.
- 1.3. The race instructions and directives of the race director displayed on the day of the event and presented at the briefing before each start.
- 1.4. Participants commit under their own responsibility to start and compete in the Fort Boyard Challenge.
- 1.5. Good spirit and "Fairplay".

2.ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION

- 2.1. The canoe race takes place on a TAOHE 400 canoe provided by the organization.
- 2.2. The golf events take place at Golf Rochefort Océan with appropriate equipment (left-handed, right-handed, tall, short).
- 2.3. Eligible competitors can register only by completing the online registration form on the website www.fortboyardchallenge.fr. The number of teams is limited to the first 30 complete applications received.
- 2.4. Team composition: Teams are composed of 4 to 5 members, 4 main members and 1 substitute (not mandatory). No minimum level of practice required. Reminder: knowing how to swim is essential.

3.FEES

The required fees are as follows: Class Amount 1 Canoe V4 350 € 2nd Canoe V4 290 € The registration fee includes: equipment rental, organization costs, safety device costs, Saturday evening, and the event t-shirt.

4.PROGRAM

Saturday, October 4th:

Reception at 9:00 am at Golf de Saint Laurent-de-la-Prée.

Briefing The event briefings will take place before each competition (Golf and canoe). It is mandatory that all teams be present.

Race days The canoe race schedules will be indicated on the official event notice board on the beach of Fouras.

5. RACE INSTRUCTIONS

The canoe race instructions will be given on the day of the event by the canoe race director and for golf, by the Golf team.

6. OUTRIGGER CANOE

The course is presented in the appendix. It is 150 to 250 meters, with start and finish at the same point (beach). It is a sprint with a buoy turn. The start procedures will be specified at the briefing. It will be, unless impossible due to sea conditions, a beach start for 4 boats simultaneously.

The finish

The ranking will be stopped on the beach when the first team member touches the ground. If the weather conditions do not allow a beach finish, the finish line will be marked between two buoys.

Surveillance and assistance on the water

The organizer is responsible for monitoring and ensuring the smooth running of the event, whether on the water or on land. This device does not prevent mutual assistance and help between boats if necessary and especially in case of a request for assistance from another team.

7. MAXIMUM CONDITIONS

It is specified that the race will be modified, neutralized, or cancelled if the wind is or becomes greater than 17 knots (force 5 and above) on any part of the course where competitors are or if the navigation conditions are not or no longer acceptable. The decision on acceptable navigation conditions will be made by the Race Director who will consider all elements (wind, current, competitors' equipment, etc.) to determine if safety is respected for all participants and companions.

8. GOLF EVENT

The organization ensures the smooth running of the events, safety, and reception of participants. Reception of teams from 9:00 am at Golf de Saint Laurent de la Prée, start of activities at 9:30 am. The ranking of the golf event will take place over 3 workshops:

- o 3 or 9 holes on Pitch & Putt Course depending on the players' level: the goal is to complete the 3 or 9 holes of golf with the fewest possible strokes. The total number of strokes of the team will be the score of the workshop (Scramble).
- Mini-golf on 6 holes: the goal is to complete the 6 holes of mini-golf with the fewest possible strokes. The total number of strokes of the team will be the score of the workshop.
- A virtual "fish fishing" on the practice (training area): each team must catch the largest number of fish to get the most points possible. The team's score on this workshop will be used to break ties on the first two workshops. The addition of the scores of the three workshops will give the final team ranking of the event. "Good game" The Scramble format in golf is a team golf game format. Each player of the team takes their shot. The team then chooses the best ball among those played and all players play their next shot

from the chosen ball. This process continues until the ball is in the hole. This format promotes camaraderie and makes the game more fun for all participants.

9. RANKING

Outrigger Canoe: The overall ranking will be established by adding the team's arrival positions in at least 2 races. Golf: The overall ranking will be established by adding the team's points in the 3 workshops.

10. REWARDS

A trophy will be awarded to the first in the overall ranking. The second and third will each receive various prizes.

11. LIABILITY RELEASE

The decision to participate in a race or to stay in the race is the sole decision of the competitors, under the responsibility of the team captain. To this end, the mandatory departure signature is considered the captain's commitment, after having read the race conditions (briefing), and releases the organizer from liability. Participants commit to wearing a flotation vest (provided) during each canoe embarkation.

12. INSURANCE

Participants must ensure that they are covered by civil liability insurance adapted to the practice of golf and Polynesian outingger canoe.

13. ENVIRONMENT

During this competition, respect the sea and the environment. It is the responsibility of each team leader to ensure the collection of their team's waste.
